Functionality	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Help links have been integrated into the product; however help content is not yet finalized.• Most web links and landing pages are currently still under development and will open temporary sites.• If you're installing Norton 360 in Japan, Korea, Taiwan or China, you'll need to modify the following settings to renew the product subscription:<ul style="list-style-type: none">⇒ From the Control Panel, choose Regional and Language Options⇒ Set Standards and format: English (United States) and change location to United States.• Background Scan toasters may not appear while Background Scans are running.• Migrating Norton 360 from XPSP2 to Vista may not work.
Backup	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Low grade media may exhibit more burn failures than higher grade varieties. Check your drive manufacturer's website for recommended media types.• When released, Norton 360 will include 2GB of online storage for no extra cost so that you can back up your important files, protect them from loss, and retrieve them any time you want.
